Information Management Systems

AIRD has seven Information Management Systems that were created as a way of harmonizing procedures, forms, and formats of partner assets. These systems operate within:

Asset Management:

Register and follow up all non-expendable property

Fuel Management:

Manage, monitor and control fuel movements and fuel consumptions of assets

Workshop and Spare Parts Management:

Manage, monitor and control workshop activities and spare part store

Warehouse Management:

Manage, monitor and control of nonfood item

Transport Management:

Movement and handling of fleets should be in accordance the general principles of Fleet Management

Personnel and Payroll Management:

Manage, monitor and control staff database, payroll and contracts

Budget Monitoring:

Manage, monitor and control expenditures against allocated and signed budget

By enhancing the control mechanisms of assets and management of inventory AIRD is able to ensure all received items are registered in the systems. Thus providing better accuracy of records and data, ability to generate reports no matter the time constraints, and reliable access to inventory management.
