


# Uganda **COUNTRY PROGRAMMES**

Humanitarian Assistance and refugee issues: effective and efficient support in logistics and supply chain:

- 01 Warehouse Management: Core Relief Items and Non-food Items are well-stored and management
- 02 Adequately manage the medical cold chain, and process National Drugs Authority relevant documentation and clear drugs import duties on behalf of UNHCR
- 03 Fuel management: stores management and fuel served to UNHCR and its implementing partners' assets throughout the area of operation in a timely manner
- 04 Workshop management: Maintenance of Light Vehicles, Trucks, Generators, Motorcycle, and any other motorized assets and repairing to the expected standards
- 05 Transport: Transport of people we serve, core relief items and NFIs, and other operational supplies
