Greetings to you all. I hope you are all well.

I am glad to share a few updates from the month of August.

Recognition of the Great Work-Country Programs

Chad

Chad has demonstrated remarkable dedication in supporting refugees by safely relocating nearly 56,000 people from the Chad–Sudan border (Tiné) to safer areas, including Iridimi camp, between April and early August 2025. This is accomplished by working alongside UNHCR and CNARR, AIRD deploying staff and logistical resources. However, when many families arrived in Iridimi without shelter and were vulnerable to rain and harsh weather, UNHCR entrusted AIRD with the task of erecting 2,029 family tents. Rising to the challenge, AIRD worked tirelessly day and night, engaging local communities and refugees to secure land and ensure smooth installation.

In just two weeks, record time, AIRD successfully installed 1,282 tents in Iridimi and 345 tents in Oure Cassoni, providing safe shelter for thousands of vulnerable families. Impressed by the efficiency of this work, UNHCR has since requested AIRD to extend tent construction to the Guereda area. This achievement stands as a testament to AIRD's commitment to refugee protection. Off-course as always, AIRD staff work 24/7, go where nobody is going as long as there is a need to address, and Love What They Do. "Hurrah" to our AIRD Chad Team.





Central African Republic

CAR is pleased to announce the resumption of the USAID-funded WASH/shelter project in Grimari and Bambari, Central African Republic, following a five-month suspension earlier this year. The restart of this vital program marks a major step in advancing shelter, water, hygiene, and sanitation support to internally displaced populations in both locations.

These achievements are restoring safe housing, improving sanitation, and providing greater access to clean water for displaced families.

The resumption of the project reflects the strong collaboration between USAID, AIRD, local authorities, and community members. By advancing construction and rehabilitation activities, the program is significantly strengthening resilience and addressing critical humanitarian needs. This in no way should be taken for granted, as several thousand projects worldwide have ceased to receive the USAID funding.
